1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 VISION & MISSION OF THE UNIVERSITY

Vision

To be a center of excellence in higher education in Sri Lanka

Mission

To develop human resources to meet the national development needs through innovative educational programmes, research and outreach programmes

1.2 HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY

The Wayamba University of Sri Lanka has enjoyed a fruitful existence of a decade and a half, having been granted University status in 1999. The institution was birthed as the Affiliated University College of the North Western Province in 1991 with two academic areas, namely, Home Science & Nutrition and Agricultural Sciences. These sections were affiliated to the University of Kelaniya and University of Peradeniya respectively. Subsequently, it became the Wayamba Campus of the Rajarata University of Sri Lanka in 1996 with two Faculties - Faculty of Agricultural Sciences and Faculty of Applied Sciences.

After that the Wayamba University of Sri Lanka was established with effect from 01st of October, 1999 for the purpose of providing, promoting and developing higher education in the branches of learning of Applied Sciences, Business Studies & Finance, Agriculture & Plantation Management and Livestock, Fisheries & Nutrition. Accordingly, four Faculties and 16 Departments of Study were assigned to the Wayamba University by the Government Notification in the Extraordinary Gazette No. 1093/8 issued on Tuesday, 17th of August, 1999

Having evolved into a fully-fledged University, today, the Wayamba University of Sri Lanka has carved an identity of its own and stands proudly on par with the other universities in the university system in Sri Lanka. It is located in two premises, Kuliypitiya and Makandura with two Faculties in each of the Premises.

The Faculties which comprise the Wayamba University of Sri Lanka and the Departments of study under each Faculty are as follows. The medium of instruction of all degree programmes is English and the duration is four years except for B.Sc. (General) Degree of the Faculty of Applied Sciences which is three years.

1.4 FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE & PLANTATION MANAGEMENT



The Faculty of Agriculture and Plantation Management (FAPM) was established in 1st October 1999 by the Government Notification in the Extraordinary Gazette No.1093/8 of Tuesday, 17 August 1999 and the faculty is located at Makandura Premises of the University.

The Faculty of Agriculture and Plantation Management offers the B.Sc. (Agriculture) Degree programme which is of four years duration. The current intake of students for this programme is 150. The faculty also offers an external degree programme of three years duration i.e.

B.Sc. (Plantation Management) Degree. This is a unique programme designed to fulfill the needs of the professionals in the plantation sector. From 2014, a revised curriculum of the B.Sc. (Agriculture) is adopted to accommodate the new developments in the job market and students have the option of selecting seven specialized areas in four departments. The research project and the in-plant training, each of one- semester duration included in the curriculum provide an advantageous position for the graduates in the job market.

The annual Agricultural Research Symposium (AGRES) of the faculty has gained wider acceptance by the scientific community and it provides an opportunity for final year students to present, discuss and debate the outcomes of their research projects.

The well qualified teaching panel of the faculty numbering thirty seven at present engages in various outreach activities and collaborative research with government and private institutes. One of these continuous collaborative researches by the faculty and Sri Lanka Cashew Corporation was able to release eight new high yielding cashew varieties.

1.5 FACULTY OF APPLIED SCIENCES



The Faculty of Applied Sciences of the Wayamba University of Sri Lanka was established with effect from 01st October, 1999 by the Government Notification in the Extraordinary Gazette No.1093/8 of Tuesday, 17 August 1999 and the faculty is located at Kuliypitiya Premises of the University. The Faculty has been making steady progress at the new premises in establishing new laboratories with increased capacity, staging an annual symposium, an exhibition and gradually increasing the annual student intake by 100 to 250 by the academic year 2012/2013.

The Faculty of Applied Sciences admits students from the Advanced Level Physical Science Stream who have followed Combined Mathematics and Physics at the Advanced Level Examination. The Faculty offers B.Sc. (General) degree programme which is three years duration, B.Sc. (Joint Major) Degree, B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Applied Electronics, B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Industrial Management and B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Mathematics with Statistics which are of four years duration.

At present Faculty has 37 Academic staff members. Almost all courses of the academic programmes are delivered by the internal academic staff with little dependence on visiting staff for a few courses on very special areas such as Law and Actuarial Science.

In addition, there are student led Academic Societies in each department functioning under the patronage of academic staff, with facilitate student's active participation in a variety of co-curricular activities such as conducting and organizing exhibitions, seminars, workshops, competitions and out-reach activities.

1.6 FACULTY OF BUSINESS STUDIES & FINANCE



The Faculty of Business Studies and Finance of the Wayamba University of Sri Lanka was established on 01st October 1999 by the Government Notification in the Extraordinary Gazette No.1093/8 of Tuesday, 17 August 1999 and the faculty is located at Kuliypitiya Premises of the University.

The Faculty offers B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Accountancy & Business Finance, B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Banking & Finance, B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Business Management and B.Sc. (Special) Degree in

Insurance & Valuation which are of four years duration. All the degree programmes are conducted in English medium. In addition to the undergraduate programmes, with the passionate from private and public sectors, the faculty launched Post Graduate Diploma in Business Management (PGDBM) and Master of Business Administration (MBA) in 2005 with the noble purpose of expansion of knowledge to promote the sustainable development in Sri Lanka. Further, Faculty offers a Certificate Course in Personal Financial Management and four Diploma courses; Diploma in Insurance, Higher Diploma in Insurance, Diploma in Personal Financial Management and Diploma in Banking & Financial Studies.

At present Faculty has 35 Academic staff members. While theoretical knowledge is provided through taught courses, every student should undergo one year in-plant training at a business enterprise or a relevant institution and write a comprehensive dissertation on an identified issue in order to fulfill the academic requirements of each degree programme. The Faculty was able to initiate three journals, namely Wayamba Journal of Management, Journal of Accountancy & Finance and Journal of Insurance.

1.7 FACULTY OF LIVESTOCK, FISHERIES & NUTRITION



The Faculty of Livestock, Fisheries and Nutrition along with other three faculties was established in 1999 by the Government Notification in the Extraordinary Gazette No.1093/8 of Tuesday, 17 August 1999 and the faculty is located at Makandura Premises of the University.

The faculty offers two degree programmes which are four years duration; B.Sc. in Food Science & Nutrition Degree and B.Sc. in Food Production & Technology Management Degree. B.Sc. in Food Science & Nutrition Degree programme was introduced in 2001 and B.Sc. in Food Production & Technology Management Degree programme was introduced in 2009.

FLFN is well recognized as one of the Sri Lanka's latest and modern learning and research institutions. Nationally acclaimed for its well qualified teaching staff, experienced researchers and modern high quality learning facilities, the faculty possesses a reputation for quality and excellence in higher education and research. At present Faculty has 34 Academic staff members. Being the leading education provider in food & nutrition, the faculty has introduced innovative job-oriented courses and curricular to cater the needs of the stakeholders in the sectors.

All degree programmes in FLFN are well designed to equip students with IT skills and mastery of English Language. The learning atmosphere at the Faculty is very conducive for learning. In ensuring teaching excellence, Faculty adopts flexible learning as part of its overall strategy to deliver an enhanced student-centered approach to education. Apart from imparting knowledge, all courses aim at developing personality of the students by improving leadership, interpersonal relationships, communication, analytical and critical thinking.

1.8 LIBRARY



The main Library at Kuliyaipitiya Premises and the Library at Makandura Premises serve the undergraduate programmes conducted at the respective Premises, in the form of books, journals including e-journals, CDs, DVDs etc. They also possess a large number of material in general fields. Both Libraries serve the students and staff (academic, administrative and non-academic) of the University.

1.9 INFORMATION COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY CENTERS (*KULIYAPITIYA AND MAKANDURA PREMISES*)

The two ICT Centers located in Kuliyaipitiya and Makandura Premises look after the IT requirements of the University community. In addition to supporting the IT related subjects of undergraduate programmes, the units offer courses for students and staff to enhance their career opportunities and to update their knowledge in IT. And also units offer two Diploma and two Certificate courses for external students.





1.10 ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHING UNITS

(KULIYAPITIYA AND MAKANDURA PREMISES)

The new admissions to the University start off their University career with an intensive English programme conducted by these Units before they commence their respective academic programmes. The Units serve the undergraduates throughout their undergraduate programmes with proficiency courses combined with their degree programmes. They also offer programmes for the University staff and also serve the general community outside the University by way of Workshops, seminars, English camps etc. The units are equipped with language laboratories and a large number of reading material for the use of staff and students.

1.11 PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIT

The Physical Education Unit focuses on developing the sports skills of undergraduates through standard and methodical physical education and training programmes and recreational activities. Training in sports/games is undertaken by the Unit for undergraduates to take part in inter-university, national and international level areas.



1.12 STAFF DEVELOPMENT CENTER



The center serves academic, administrative and non-academic staff for the development of their careers professionally. The Certificate Course on Staff Development offered to staff freshly recruited to the post of Lecturer (Probationary) has been offered successfully on a regular basis and staff from other Universities and institutions around Sri Lanka have participated. Another programme offered by the Center is the Professional Diploma in Teaching Technology & Methodology which is also conducted on a regular basis. The Center also offers programmes on request by various institutions.

1.13 CAREER GUIDANCE UNIT

The enhancing of quality of university undergraduates and development of professional and soft skills is looked after by the Career Guidance Unit. This is handled through personal development programmes in the form of workshops and seminars on soft skills, entrepreneurship and other related areas. Formation of student companies has been a highlight of the activities of the unit.

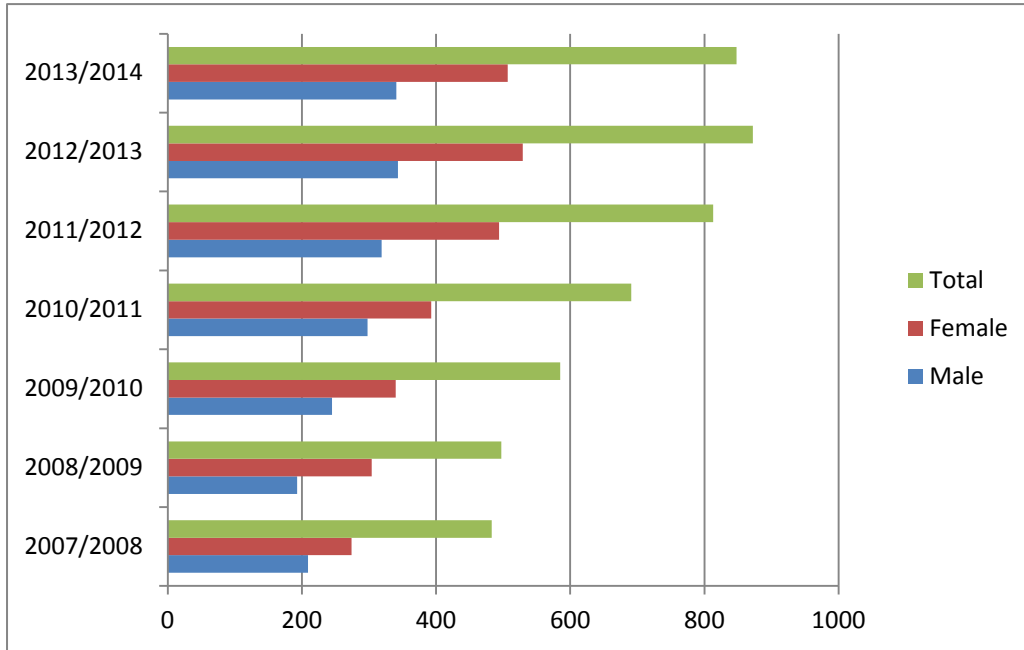

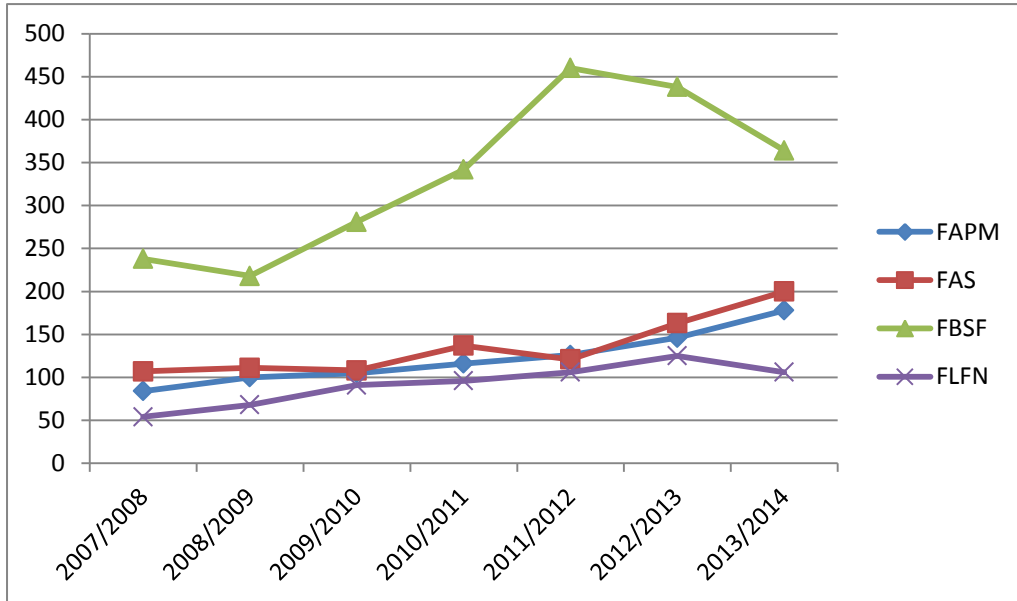

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION BY GENDER (ACADEMIC YEARS 2007/2008 – 2013/2014)

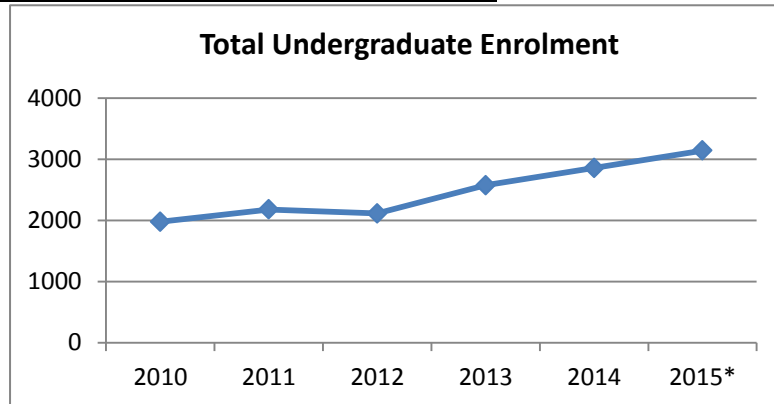


UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION BY FACULTY (ACADEMIC YEARS 2007/2008 – 2013/2014)



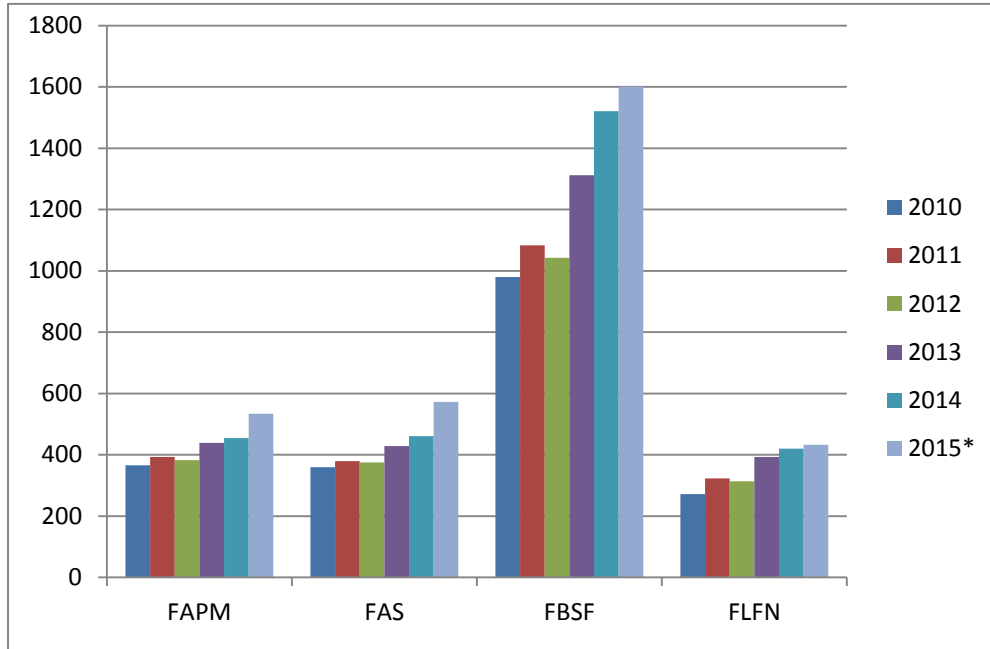

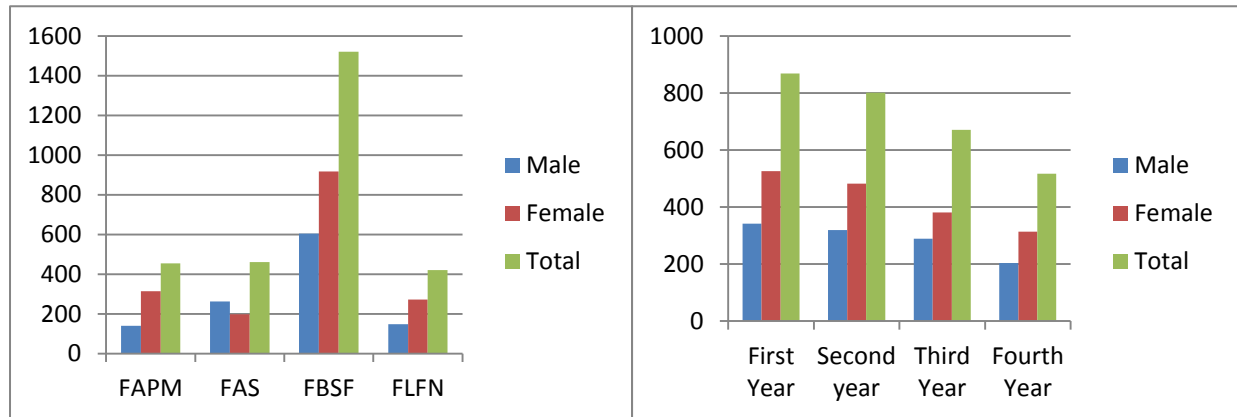
TOTAL UNDERGRADUATE ENROLMENT BY FACULTY 2010-2015*

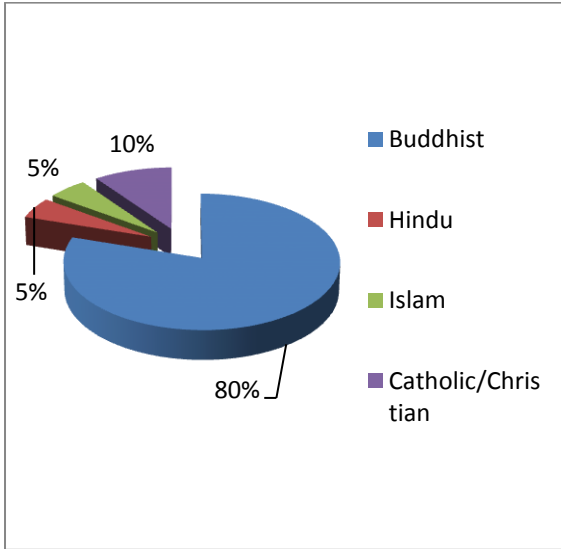

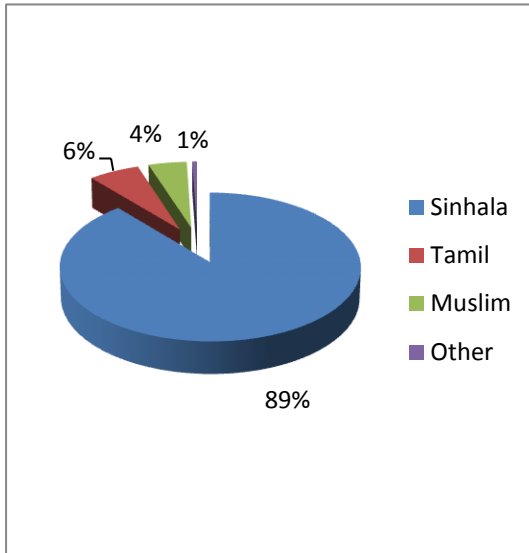

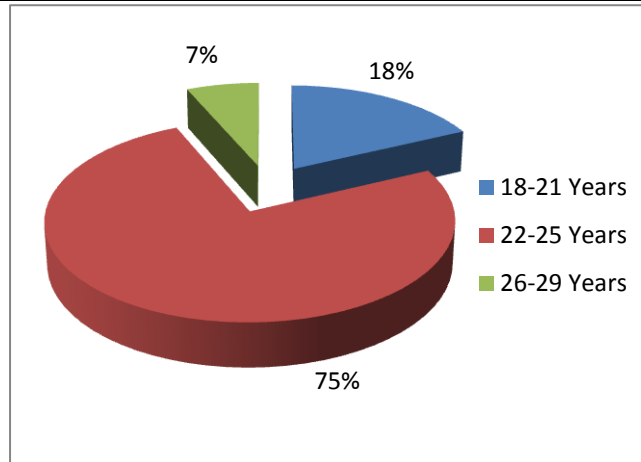
TOTAL UNDERGRADUATE ENROLMENT BY RELIGION - 2014

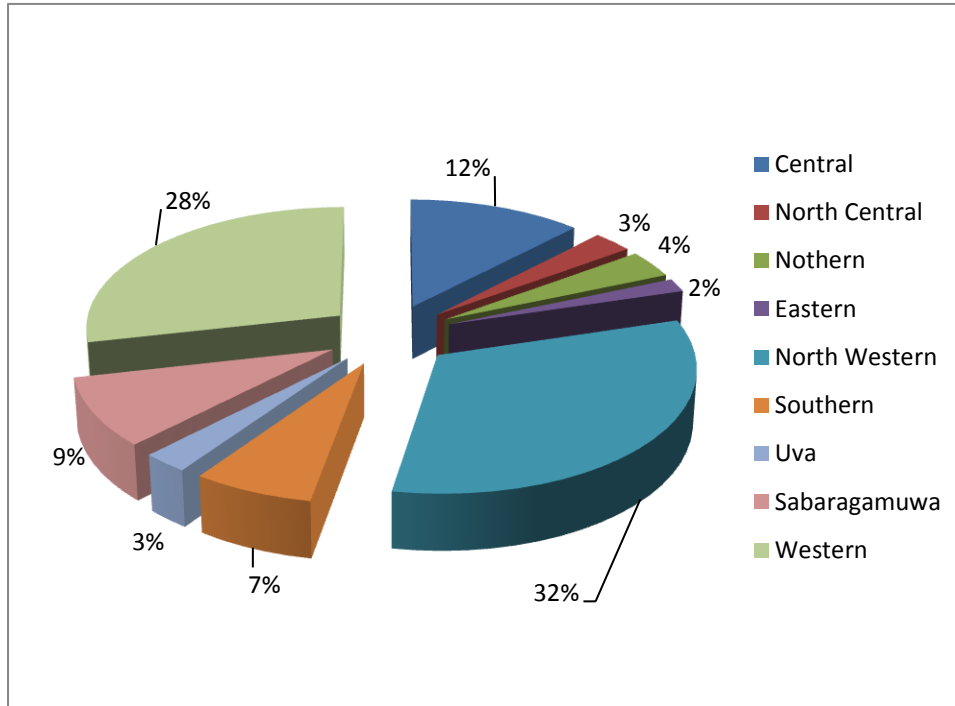

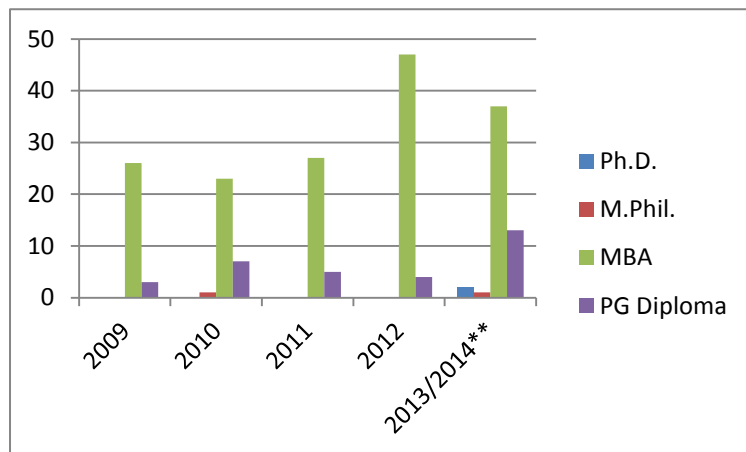


**GRADUATE OUTPUT BY FACULTY
2007-2013/2014**



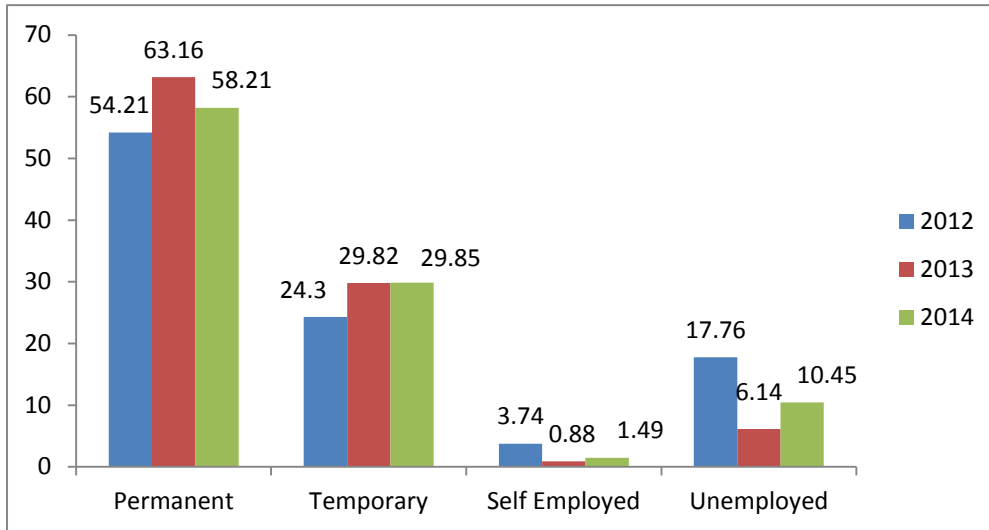

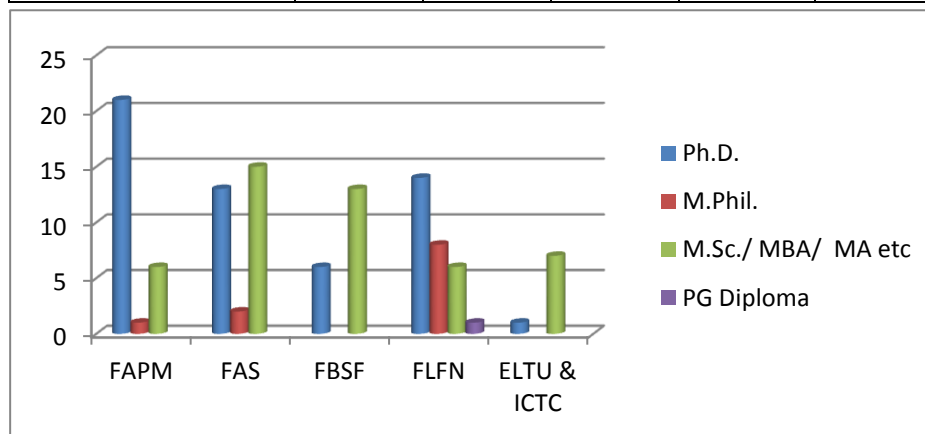

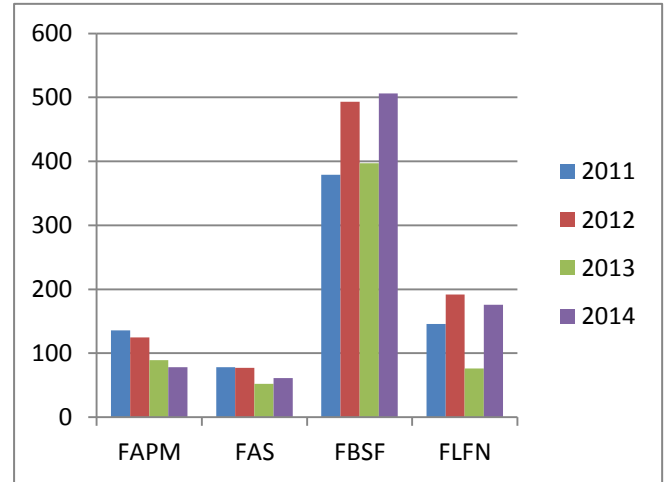
BURSARY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

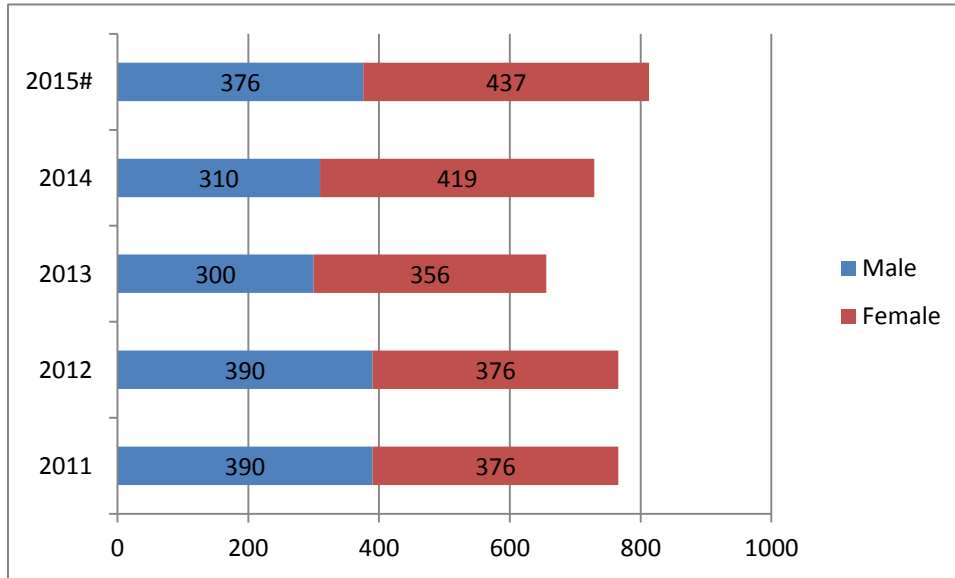

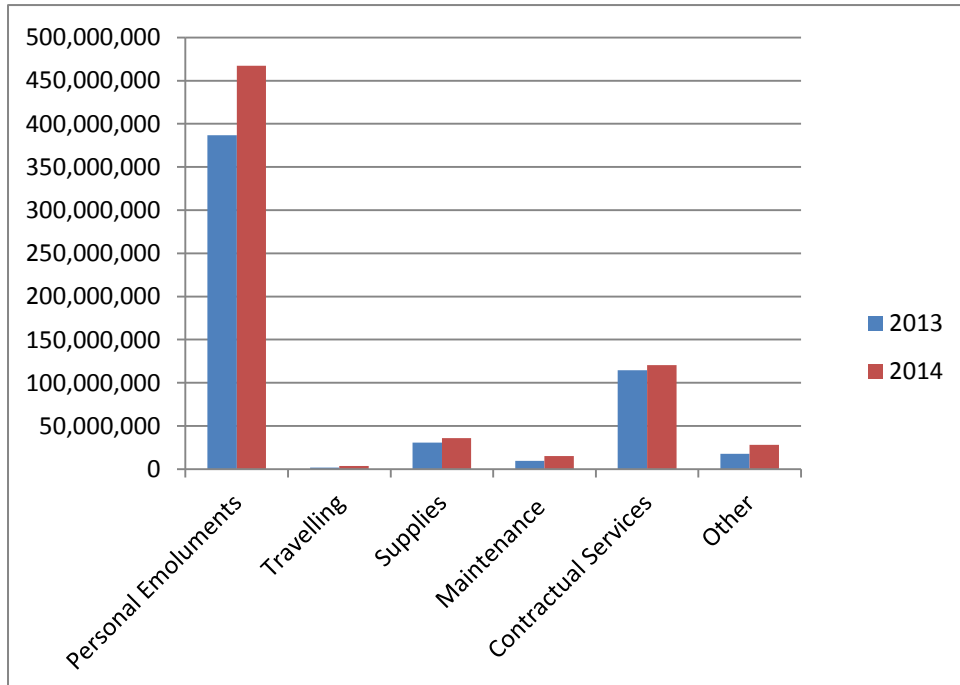

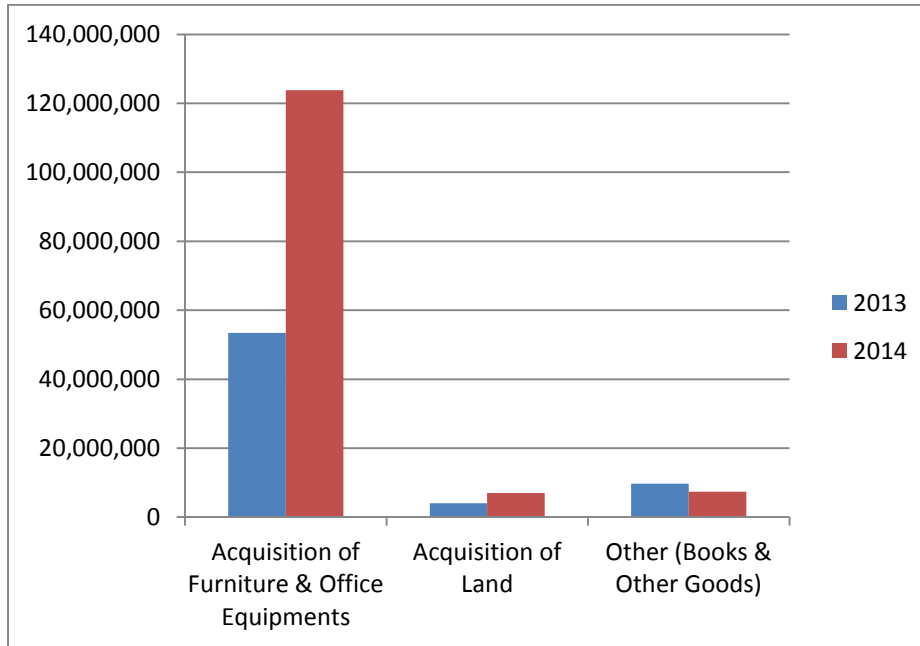

DETAILS OF RECURRENT EXPENDITURE 2013 & 2014

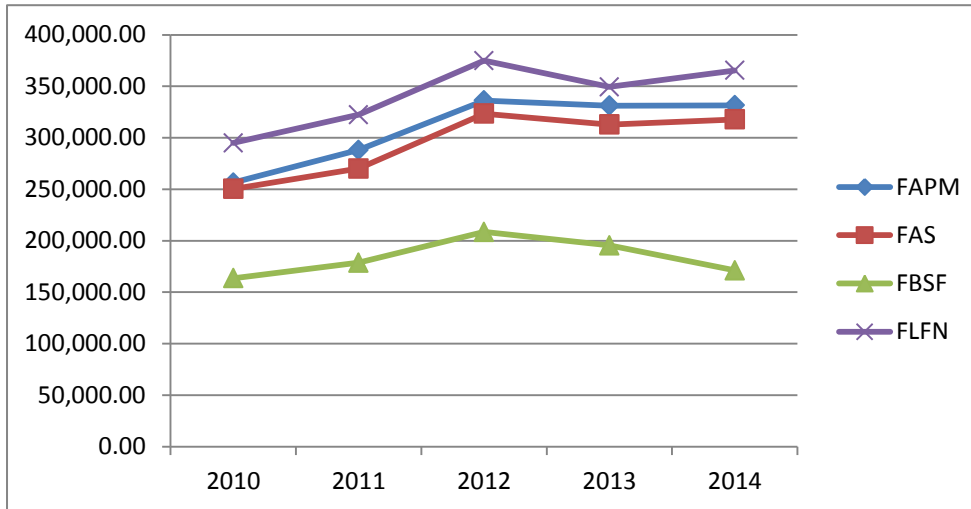


DETAILS OF CAPITAL EXPENDITURE 2013 & 2014
